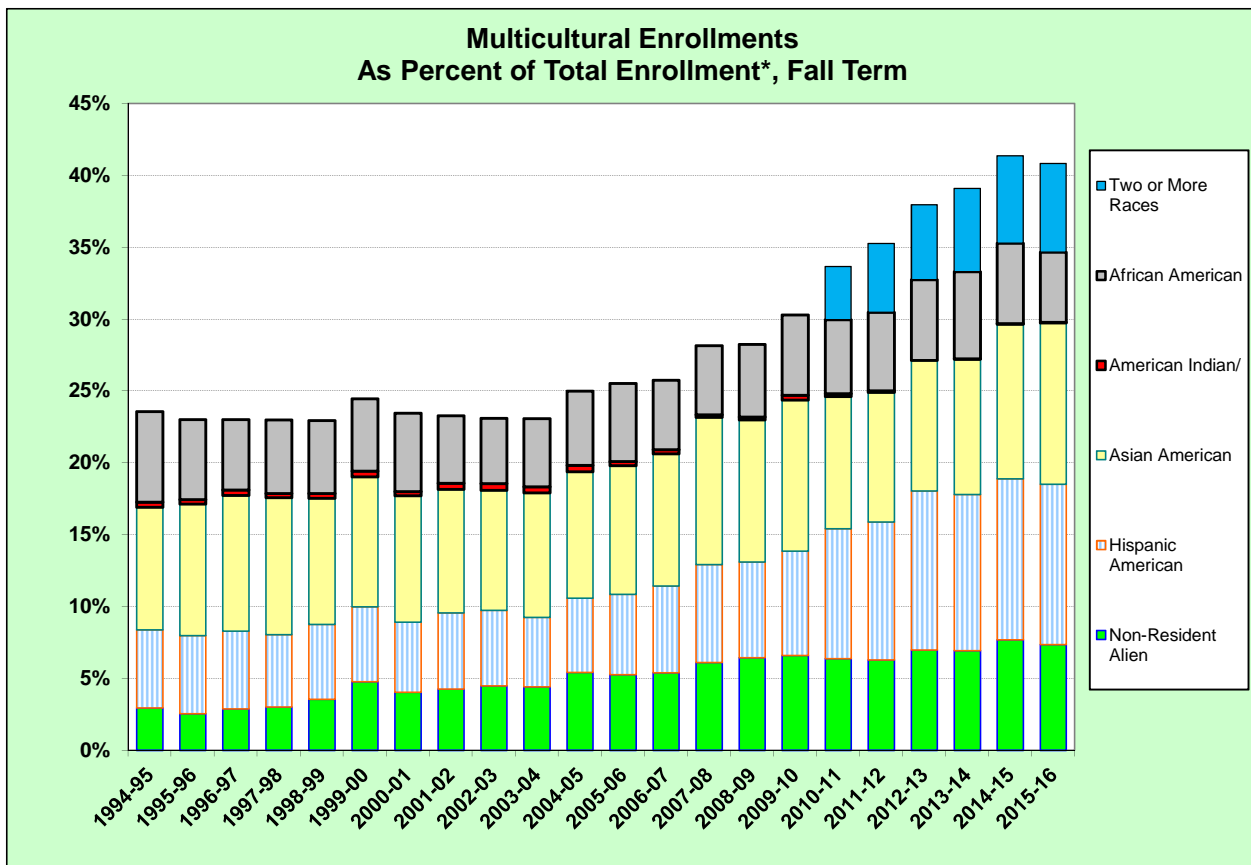

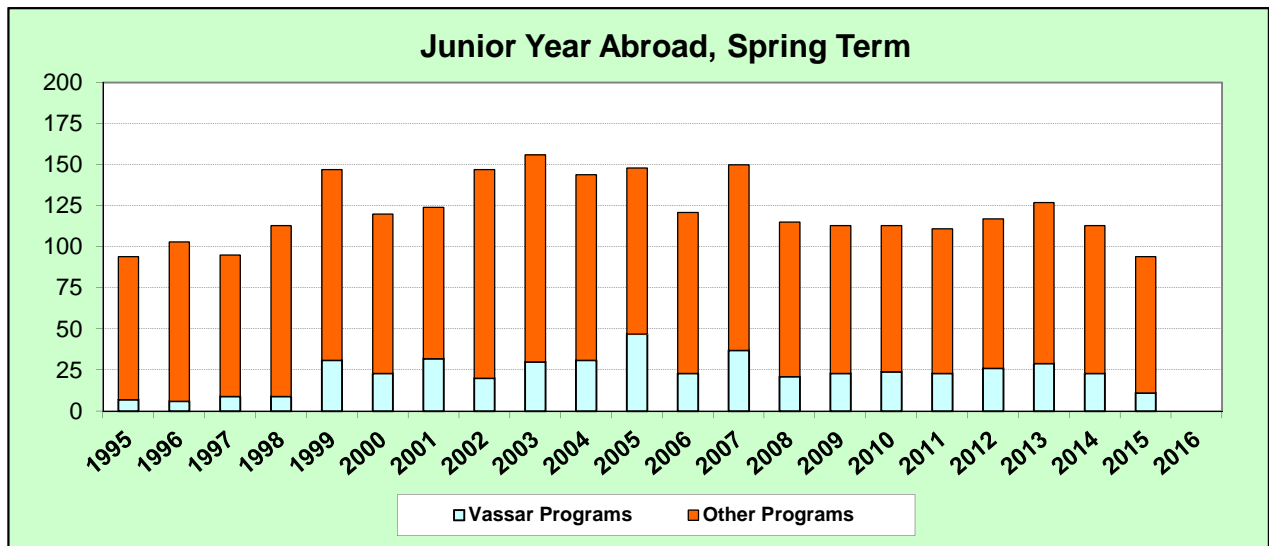

(**) The methodologies both for collecting, and for reporting, information on race/ethnic background changed fundamentally and substantially in 2010. The counts in years 2010 and beyond *cannot* be made fully compatible with those prior to 2010. Most substantial is the change from students being able to provide only one r/e background to being able now to provide more than one. Hence the addition of the line in these data for "Two or More Races." These new 2-race counts necessarily *diminish* those for most of the individual race/ethnic categories. An exception is that the new data collection and reporting rules work to *increase* the counts of Hispanic American students.

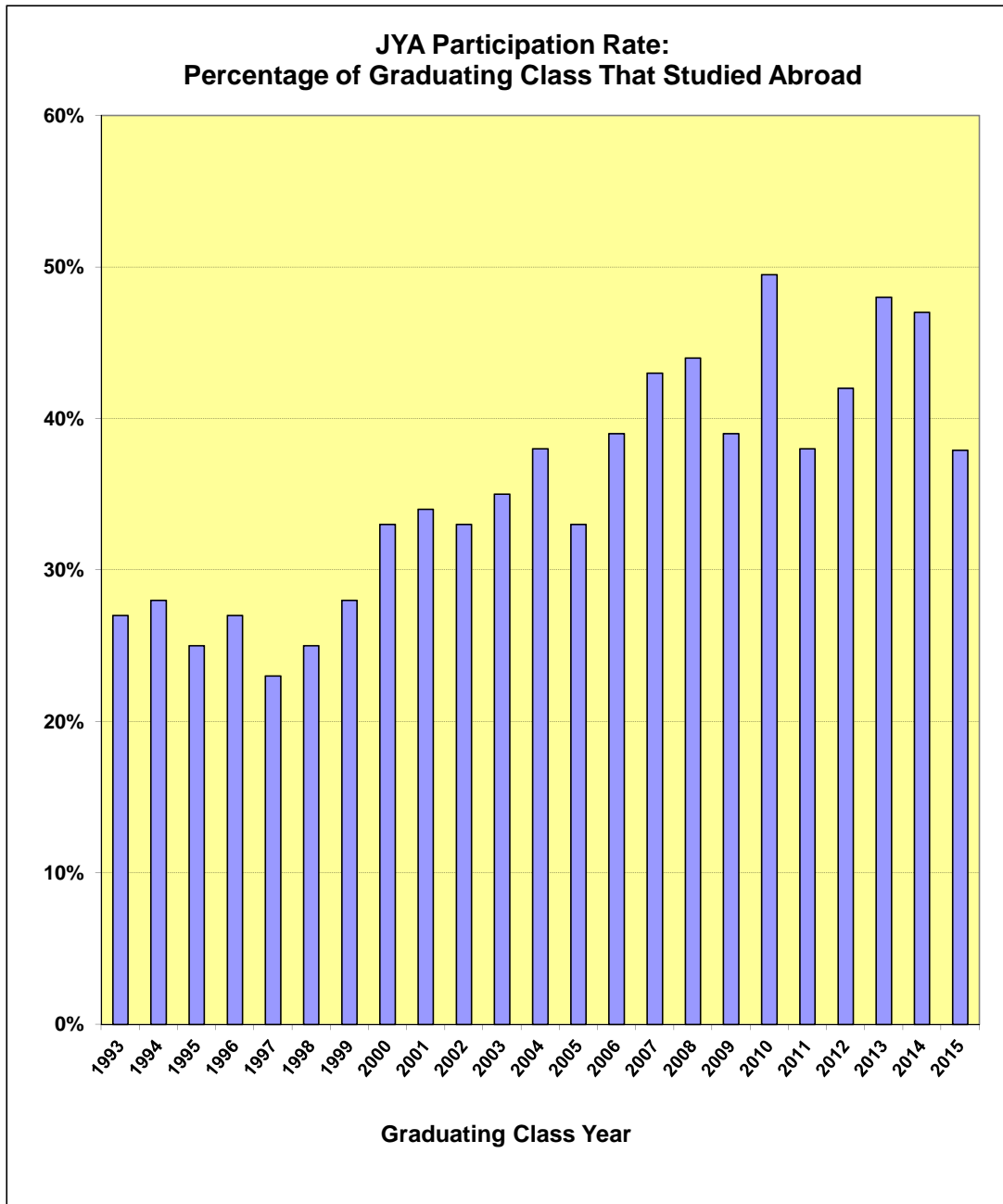
