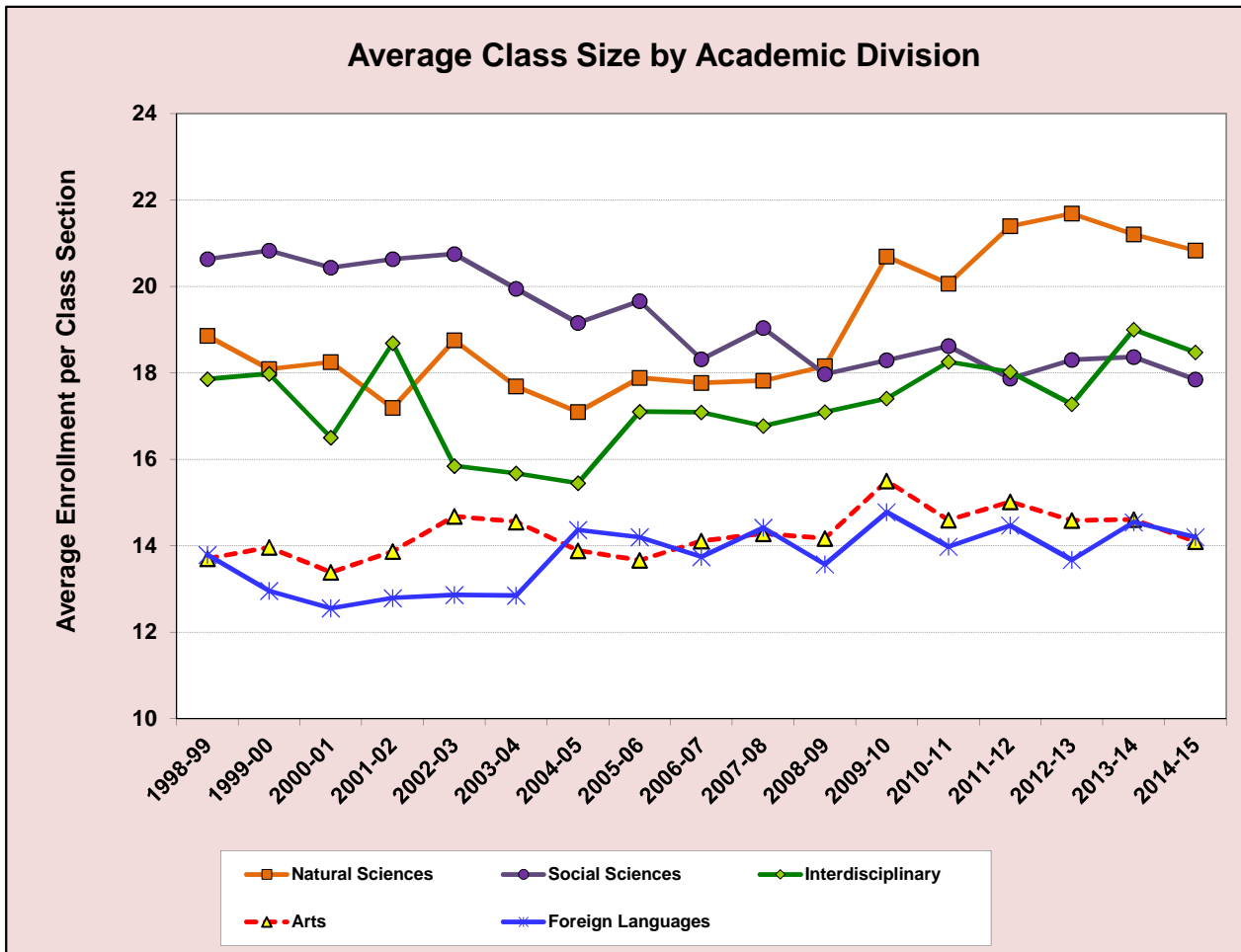

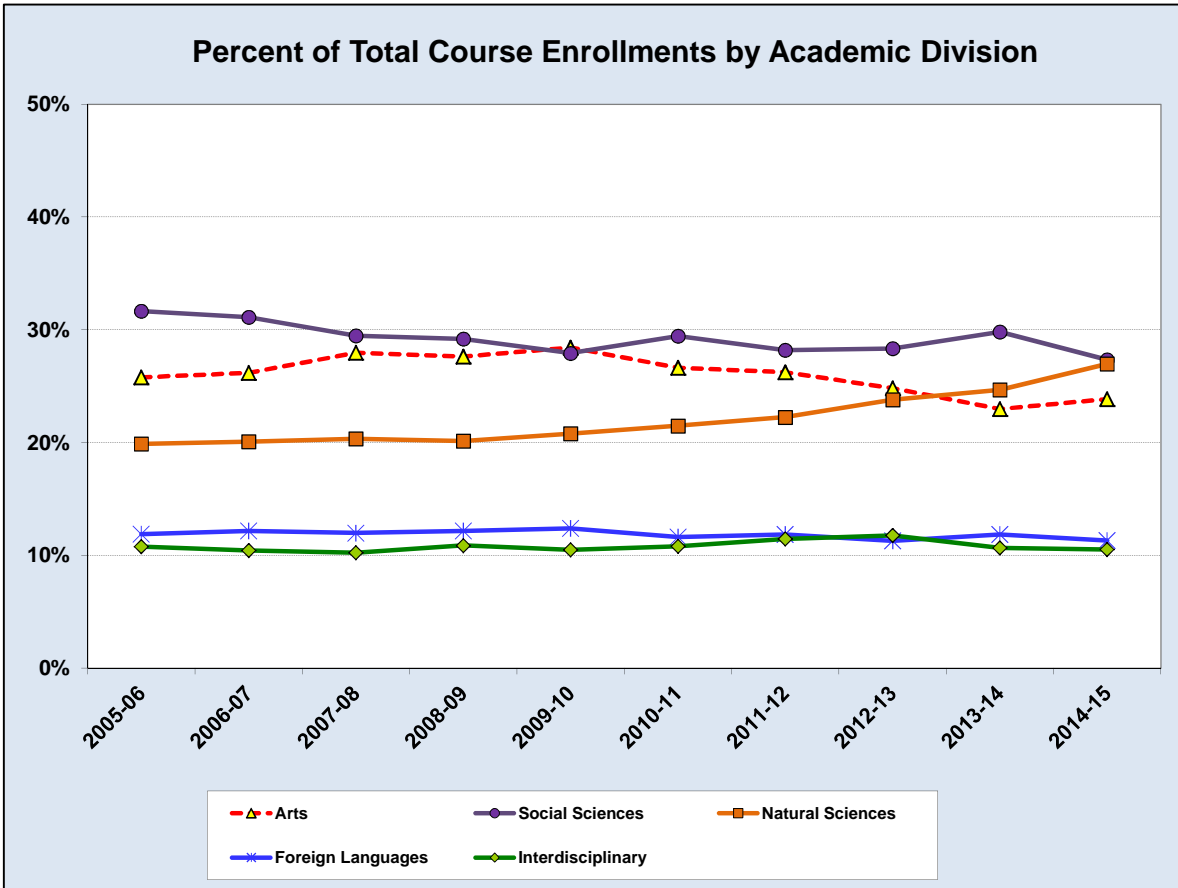
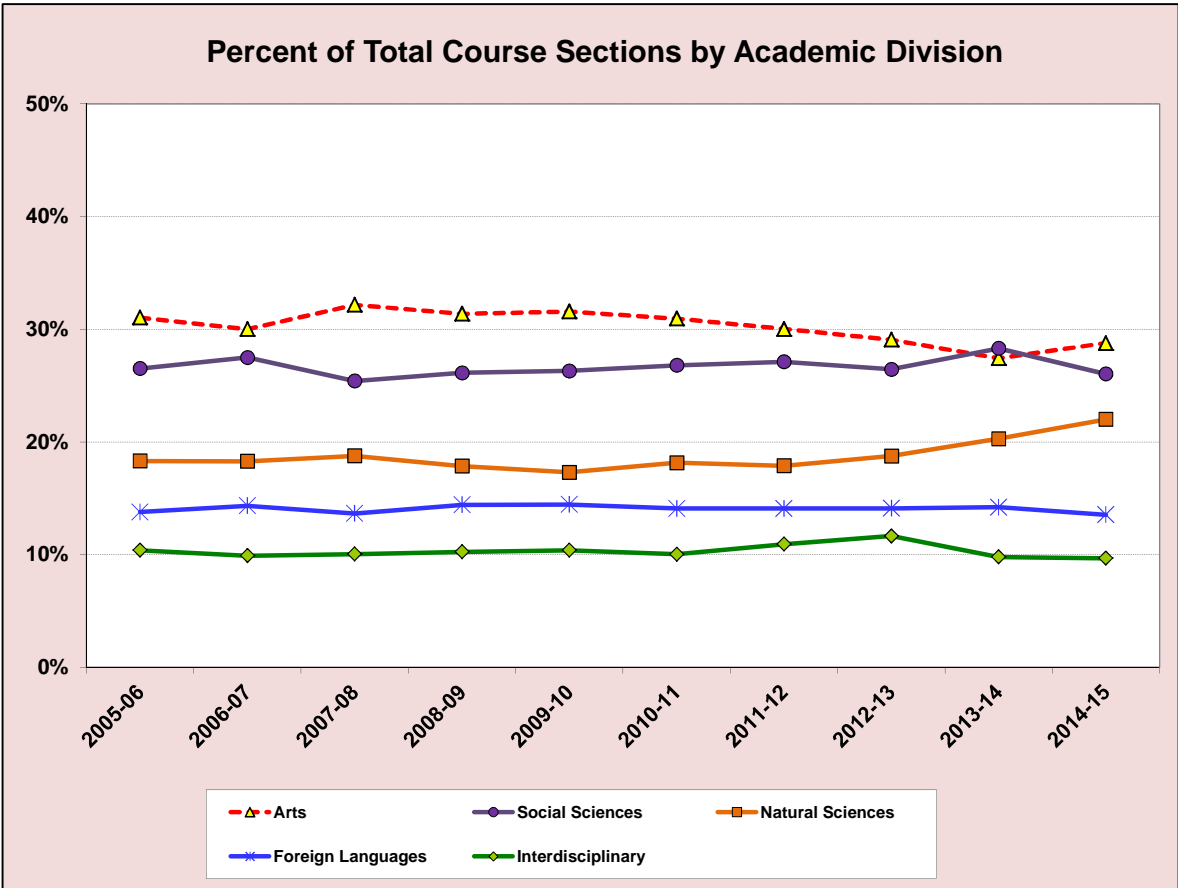
### Most Recent 3-Yr Average Class Size by Subject Area (2012-13, 2013-14, 2014-15)

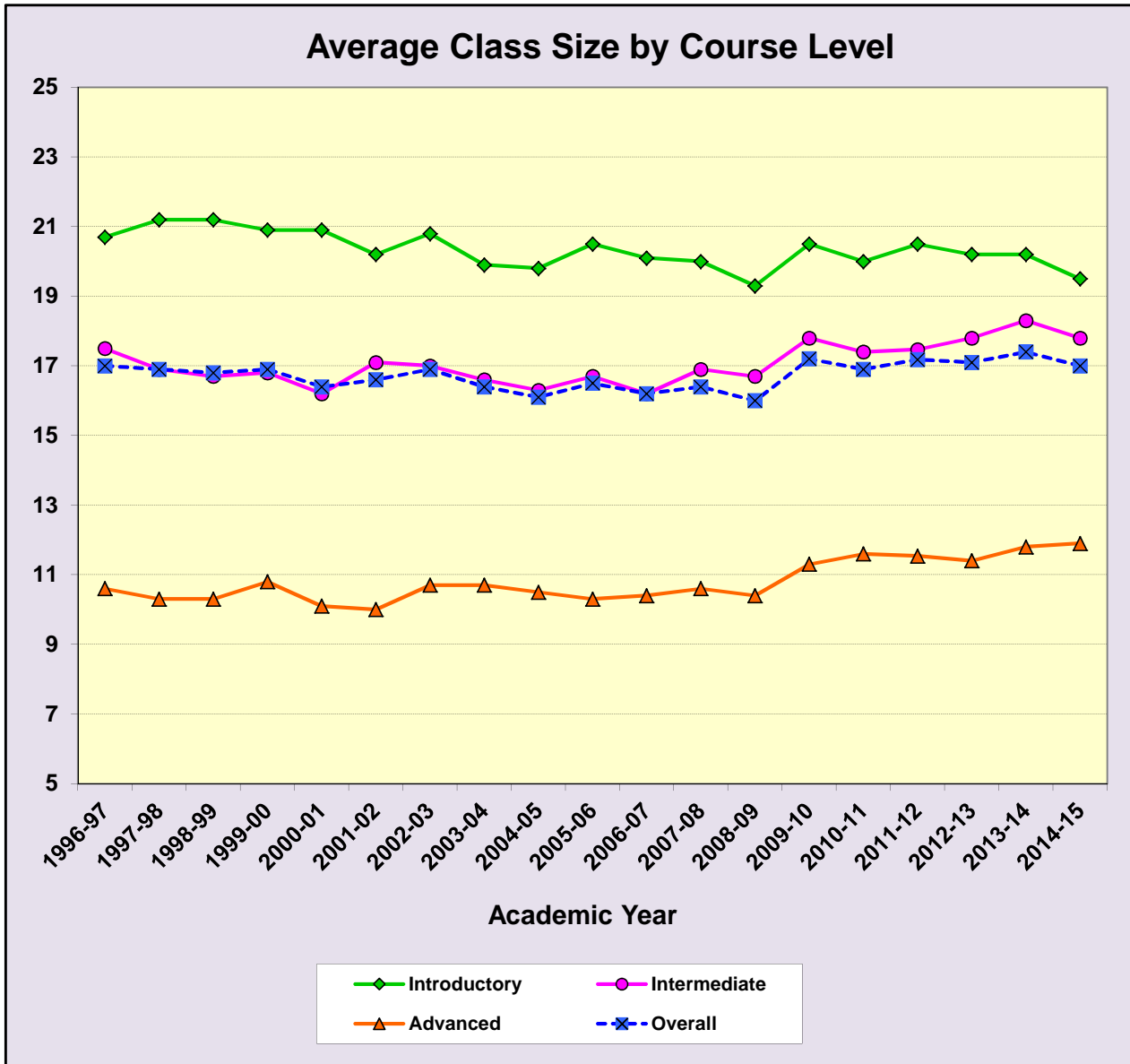

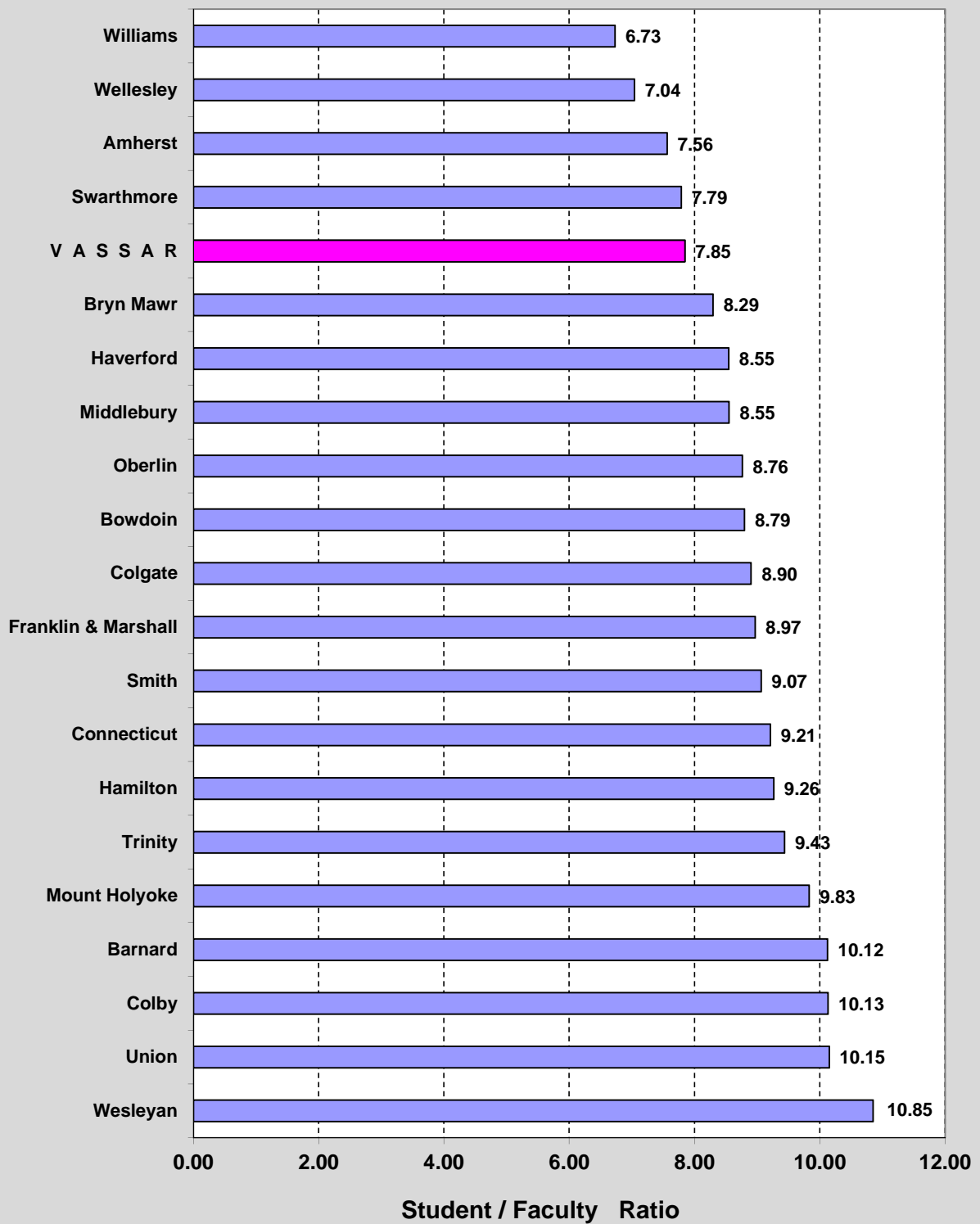
