Following extensive exploration and checking of each year's records for every employee during 2009 and 2010, and having then made several small corrections to the IPEDS reporting (for the Administrative category only, years 2001 through 2004 only), the data presented above are now considered both accurate and consistenly counted across all years reported here. The annual growth rate computed here covers years 2005 to 2010 for consistency with growth rates computed for full-time equivalent employees, p. 59.


## **Definitions:**

Faculty: Includes tenured, tenure-track, non-tenure track, and visiting instructional faculty in all academic departments and Athletics.

Administrator: Includes executive, managerial, and other salaried administrative and professional staff positions. Also, includes some employees with partial faculty status such as librarians, nursery school teachers, curators supporting an academic department, and faculty serving in administrative positions.

<u>Clerical/Paraprofessional</u>: Includes office and library support staff, laboratory technicians, nurses, and other clerical/technical staff compensated on an hourly basis.

Service: Includes employees in buildings & grounds, food services, security officers, and nursery school assistant teachers.




