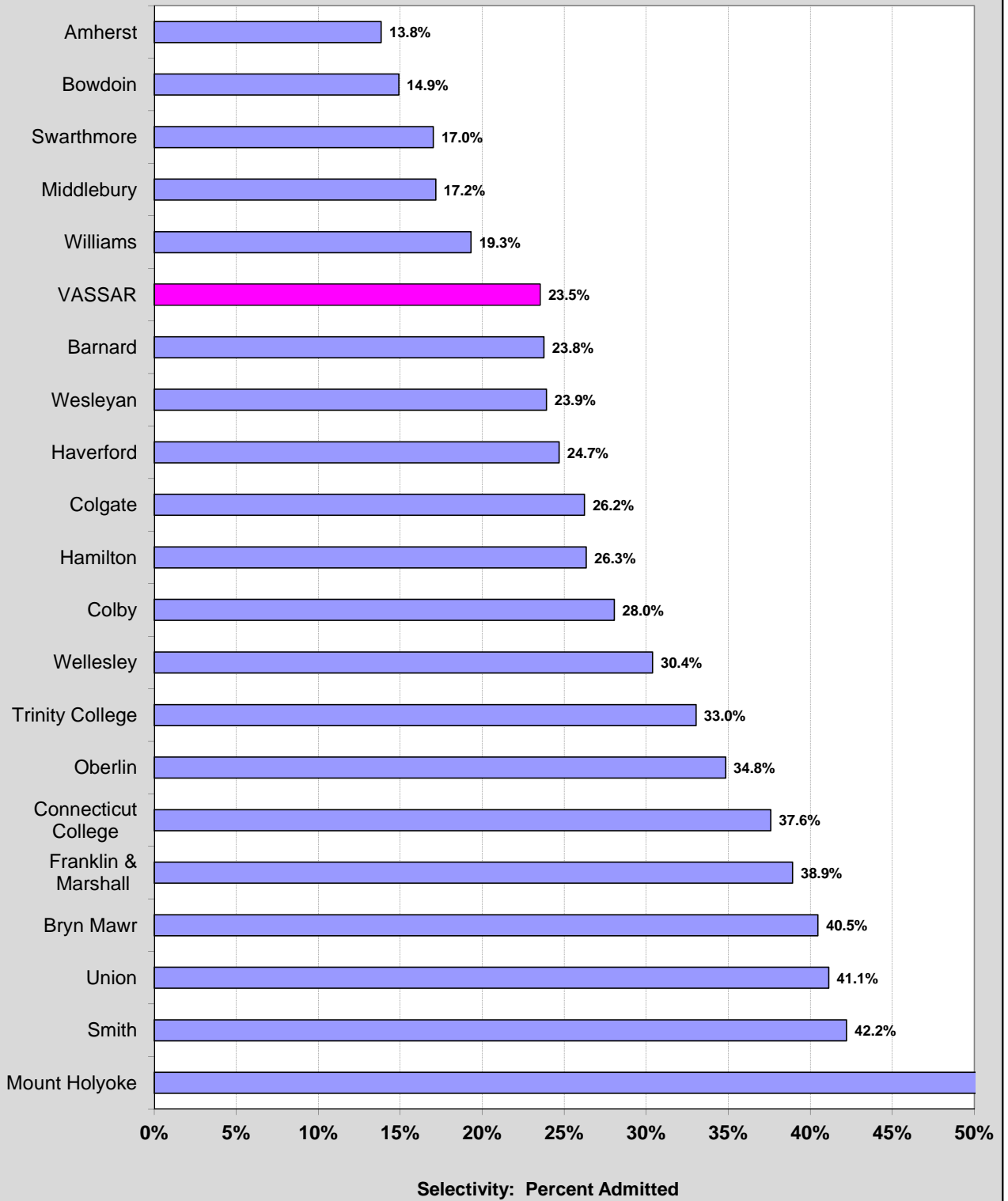

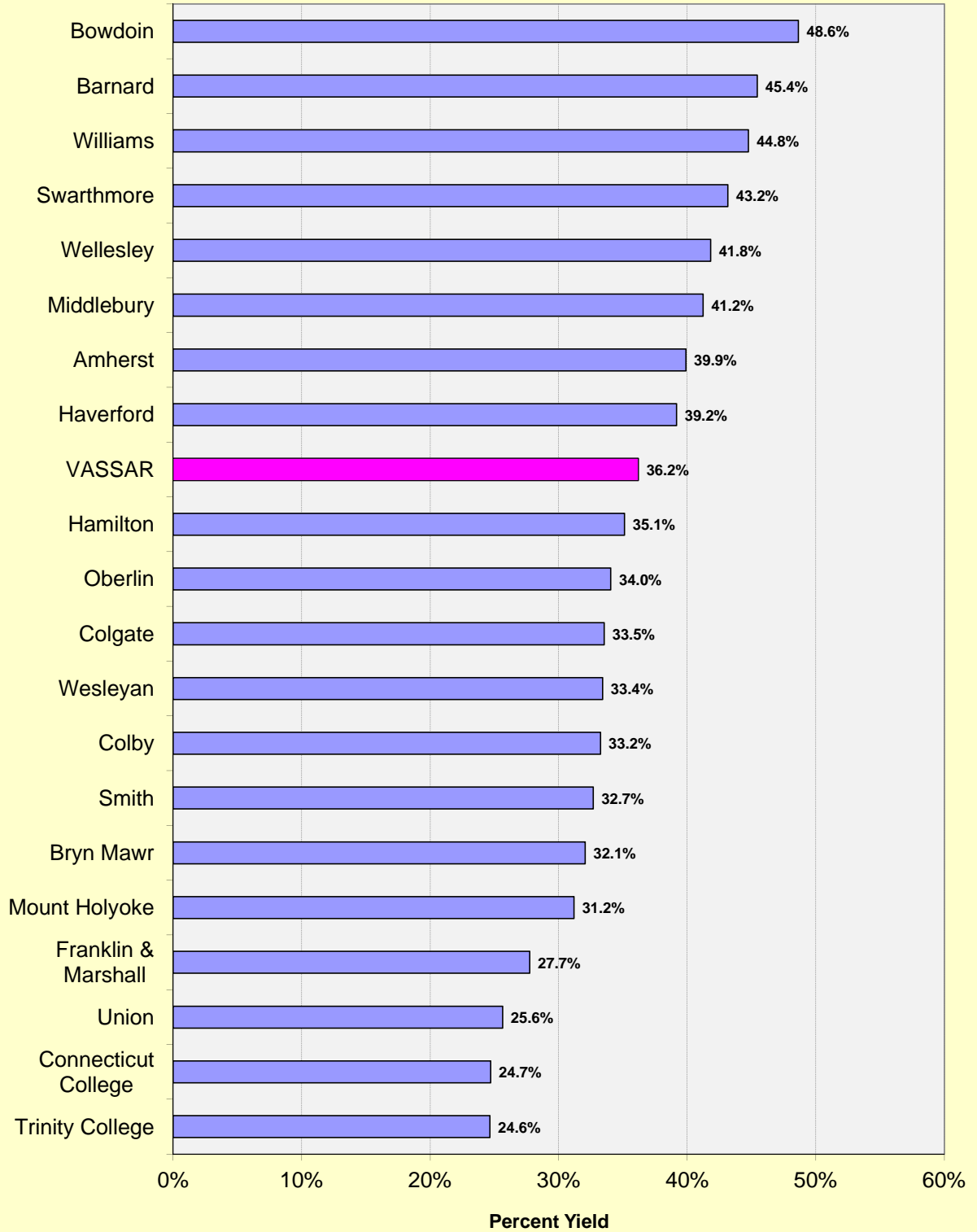




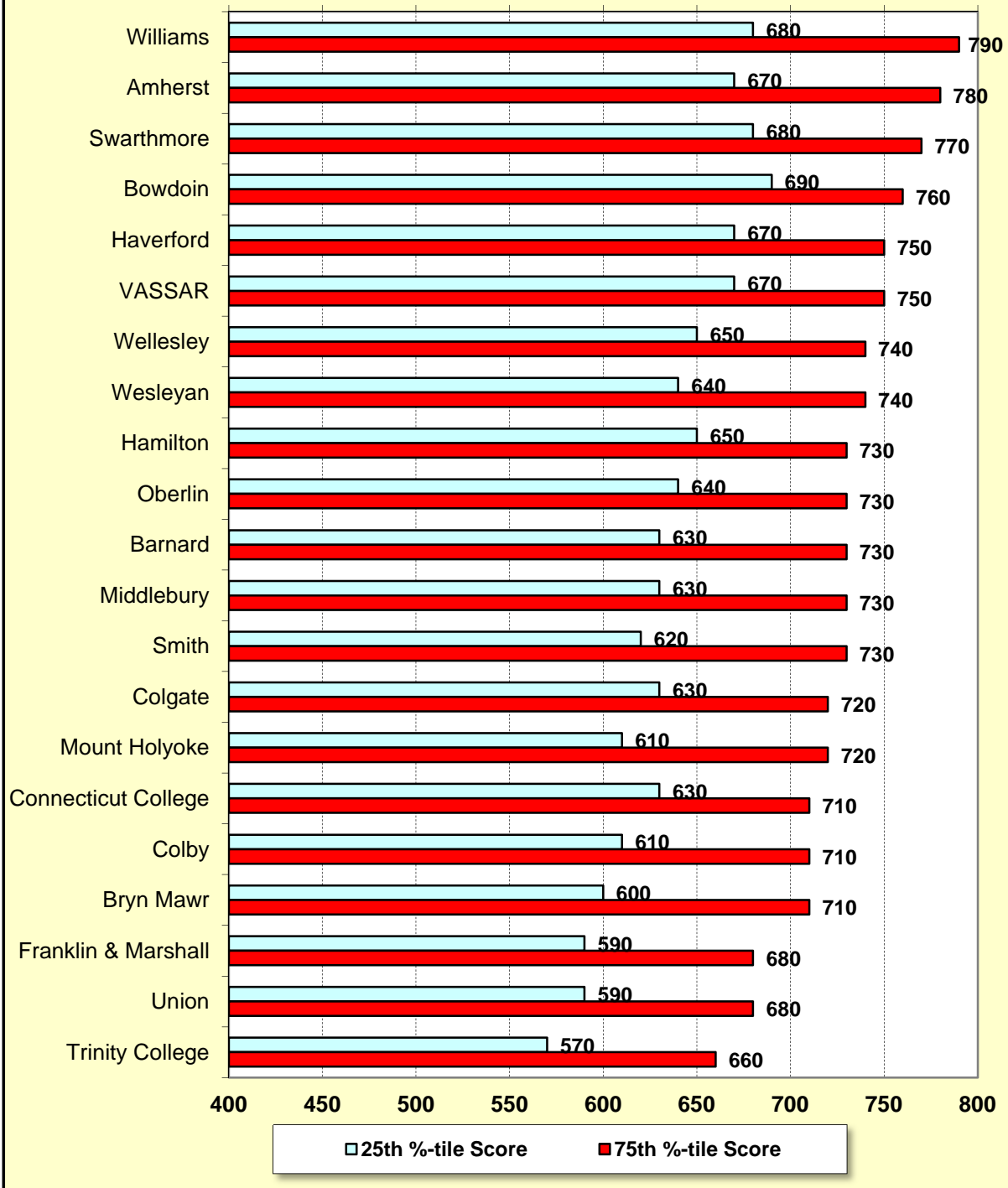
**Comparative Admissions Selectivity:

Fall, 2014**

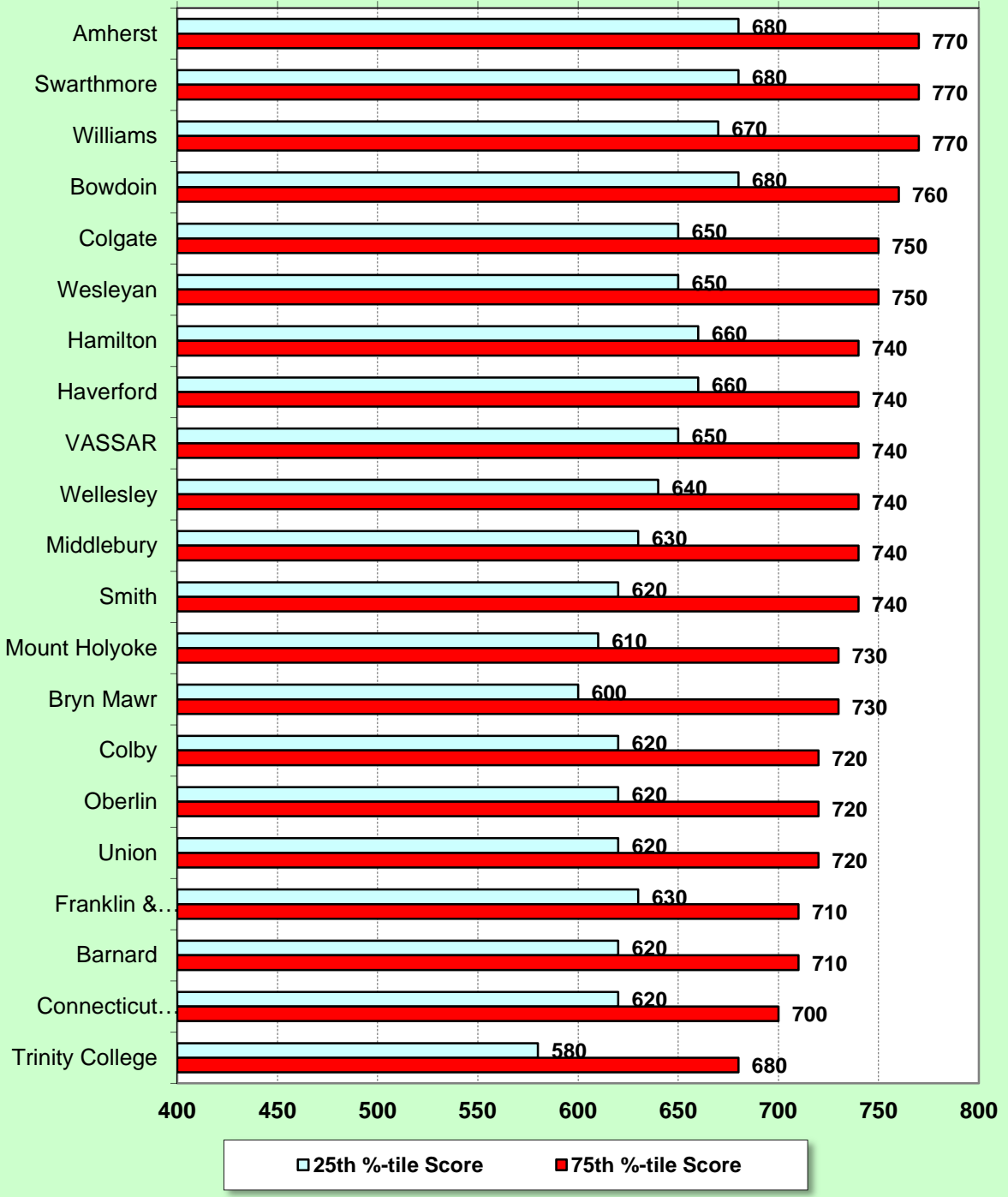


**Comparative Data for SAT Verbal Scores:

Fall, 2014**



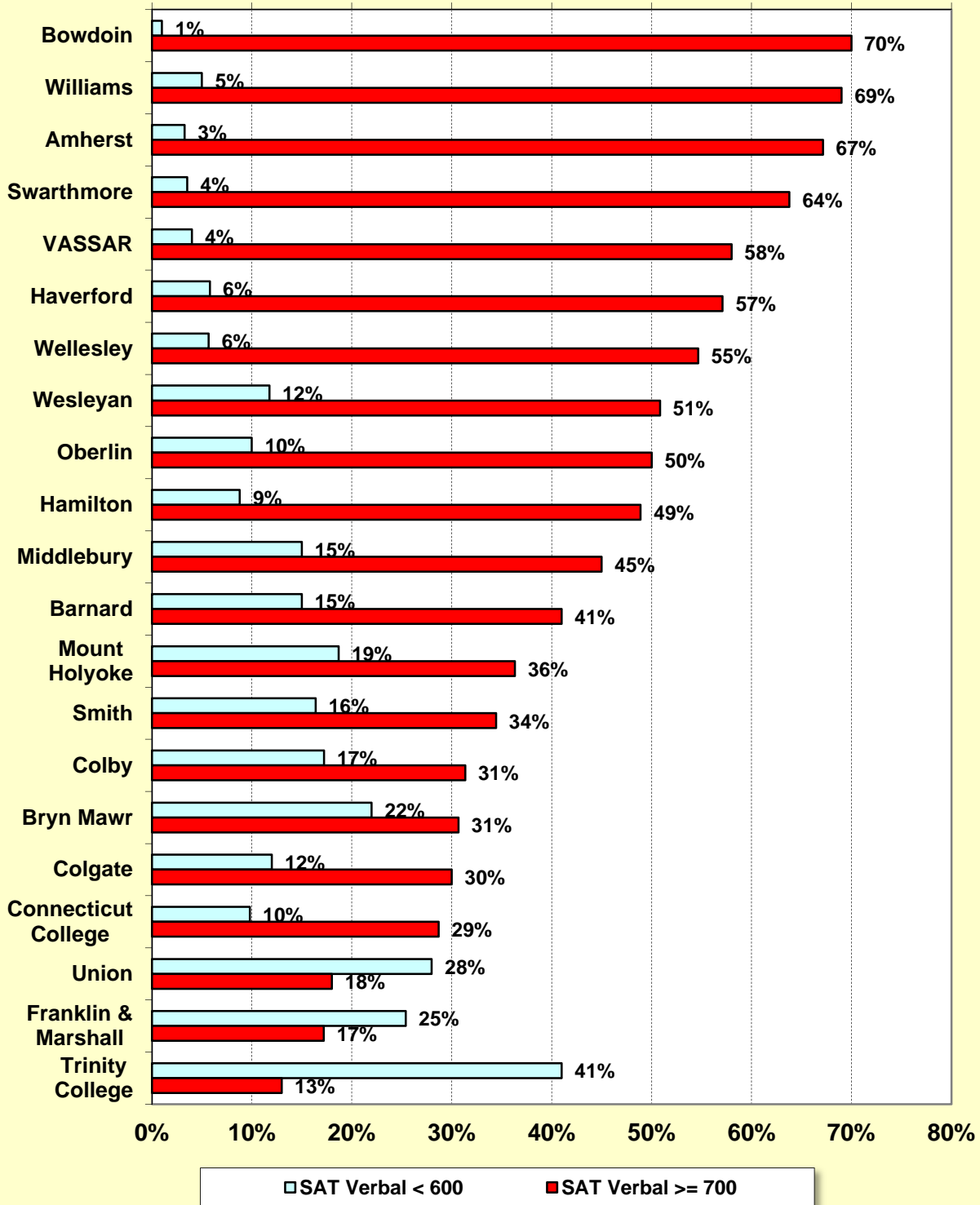

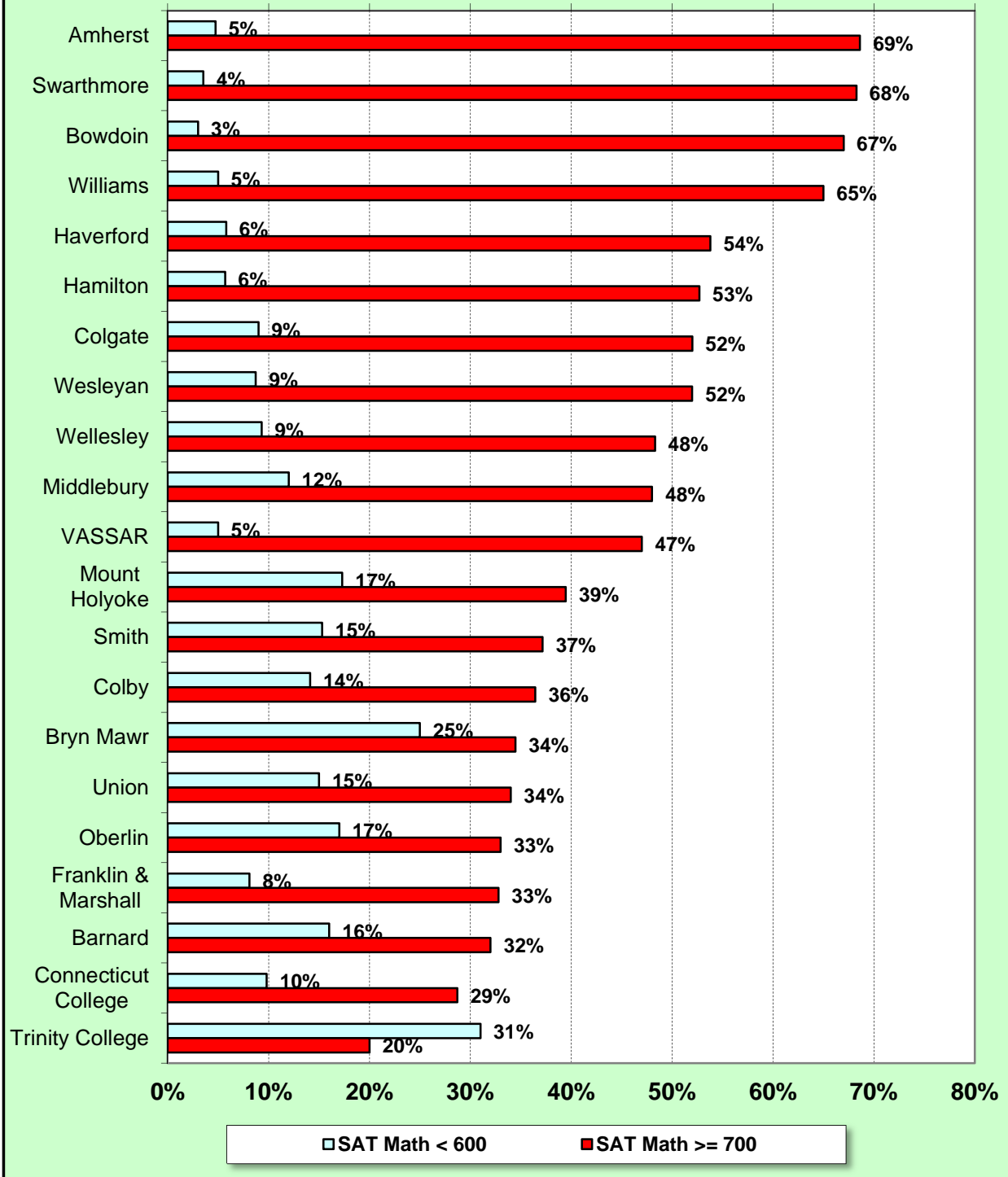

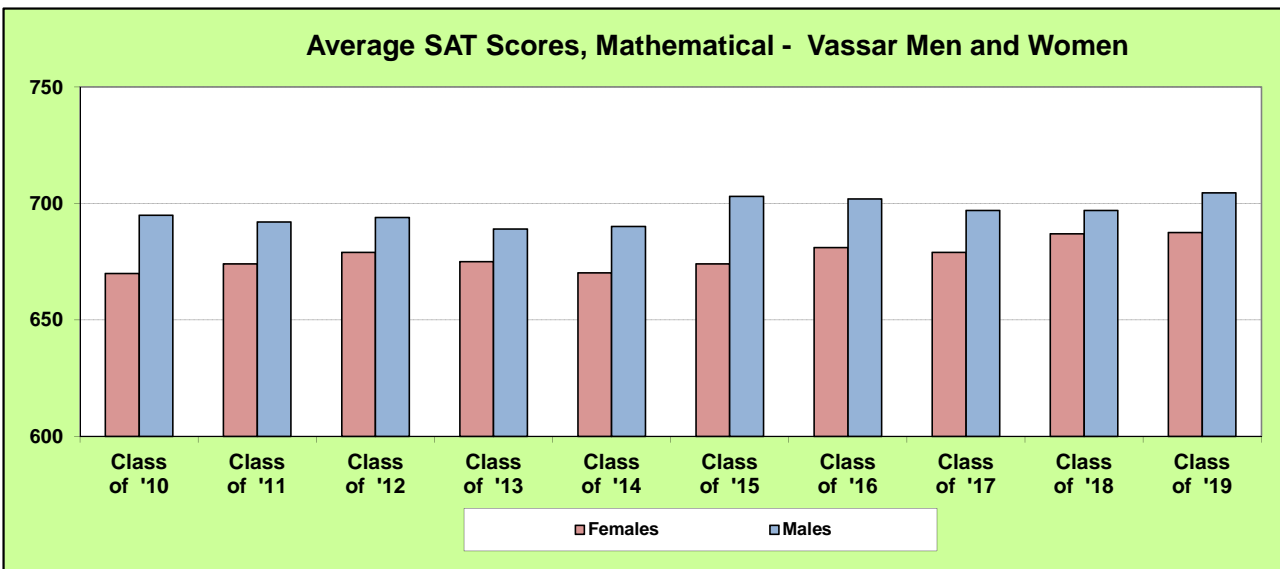
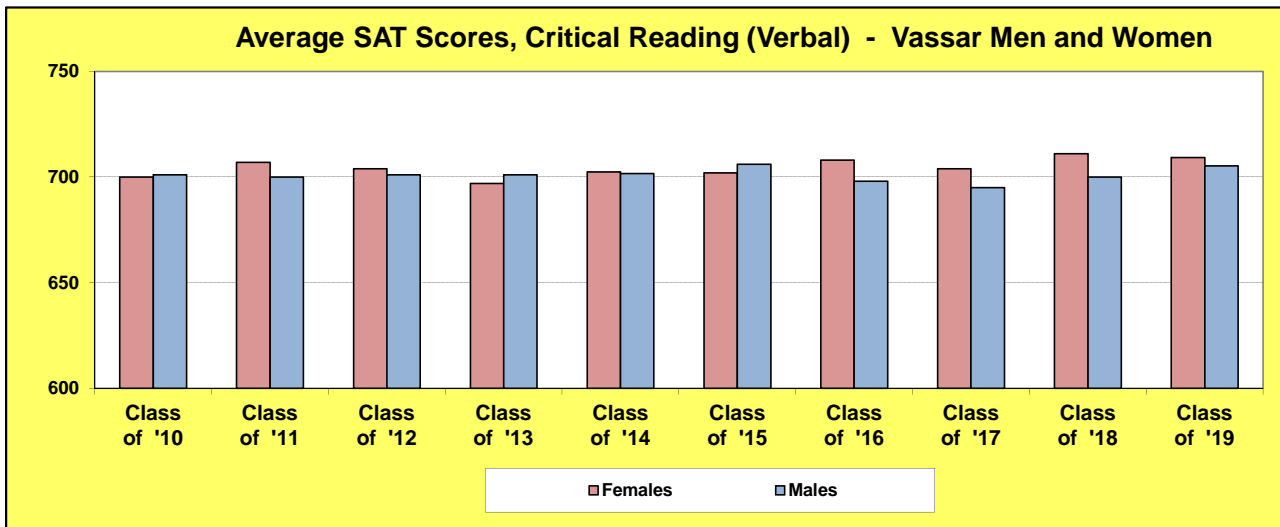

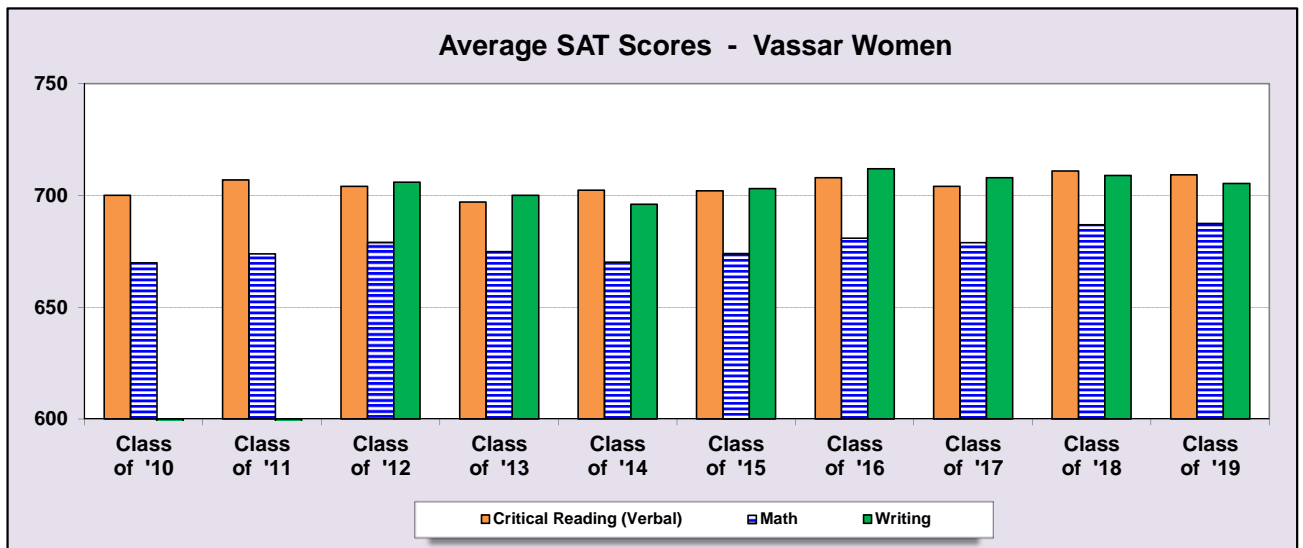

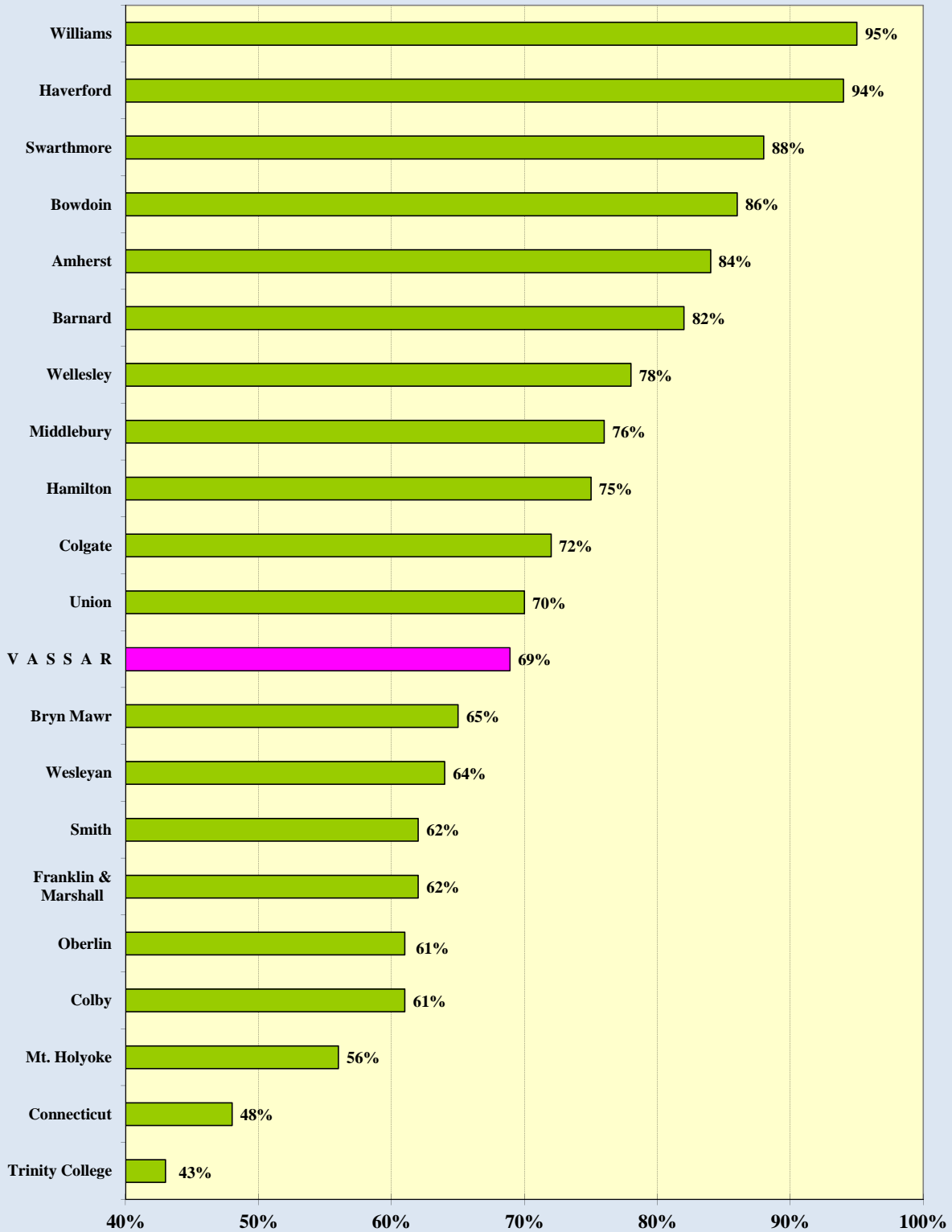

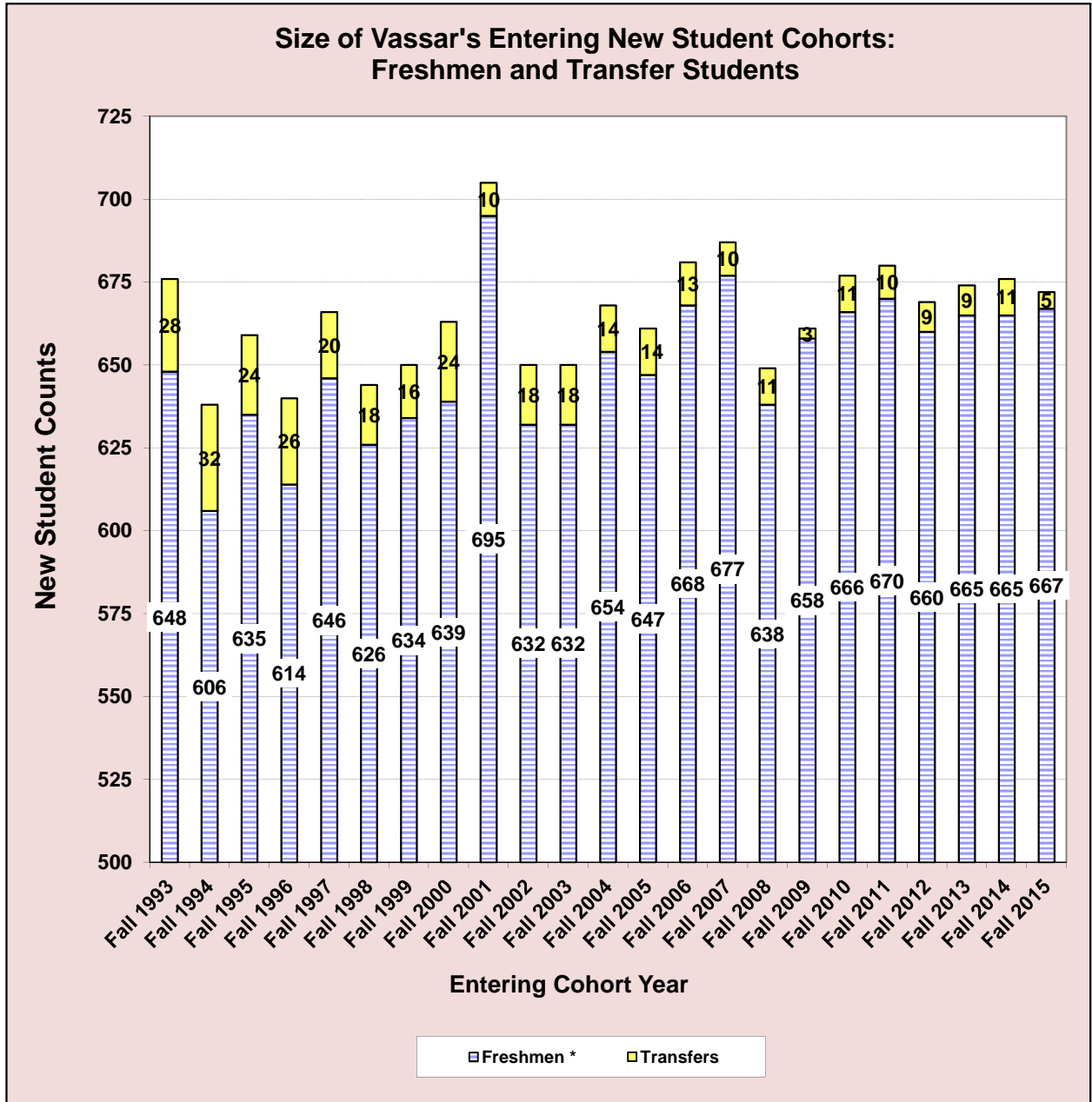


**Percent of Freshmen in Top 10% of their High School Class
