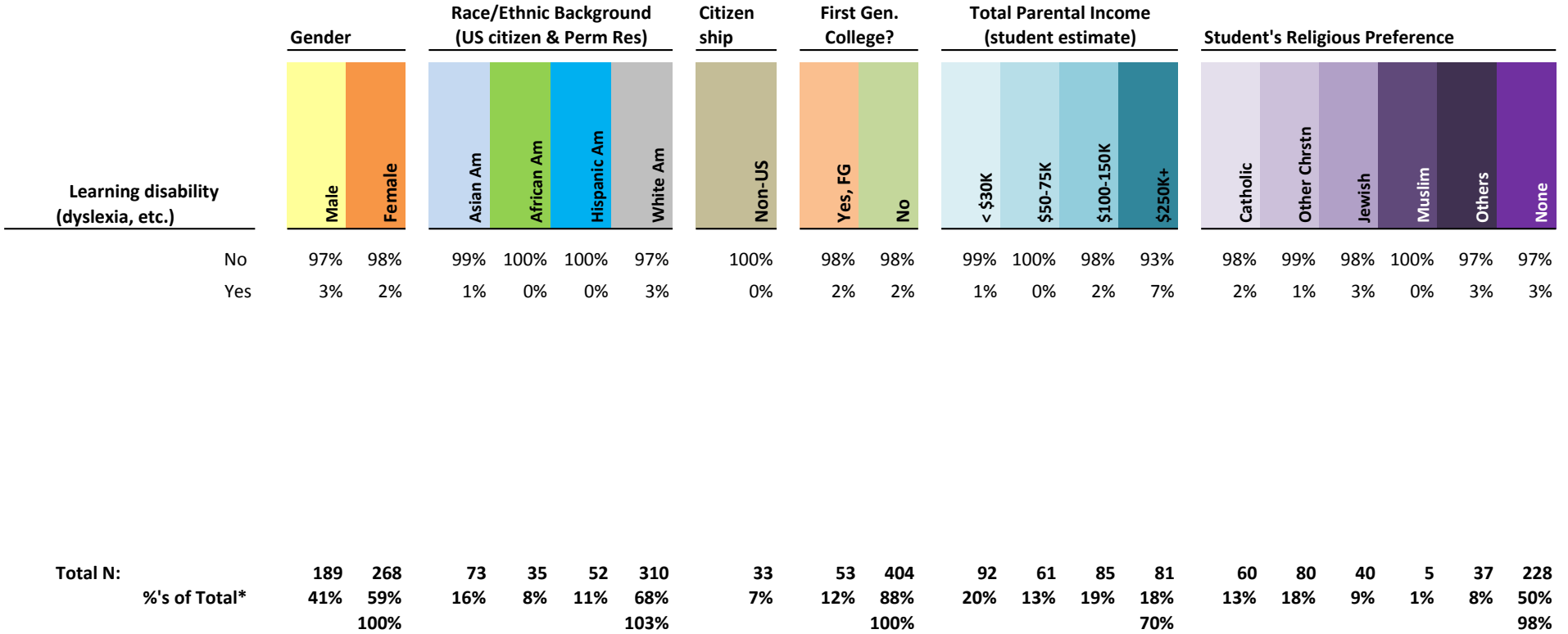

Learning disability (dyslexia, etc.)



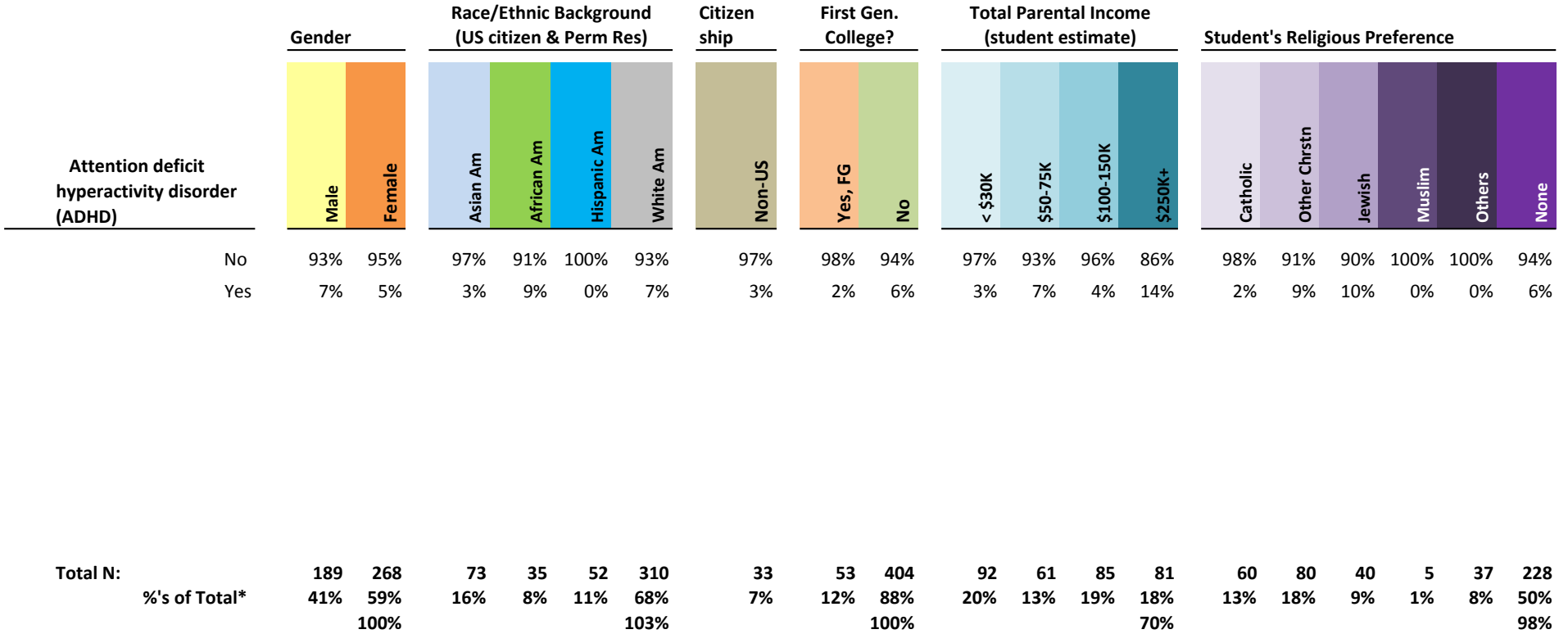

Attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD)



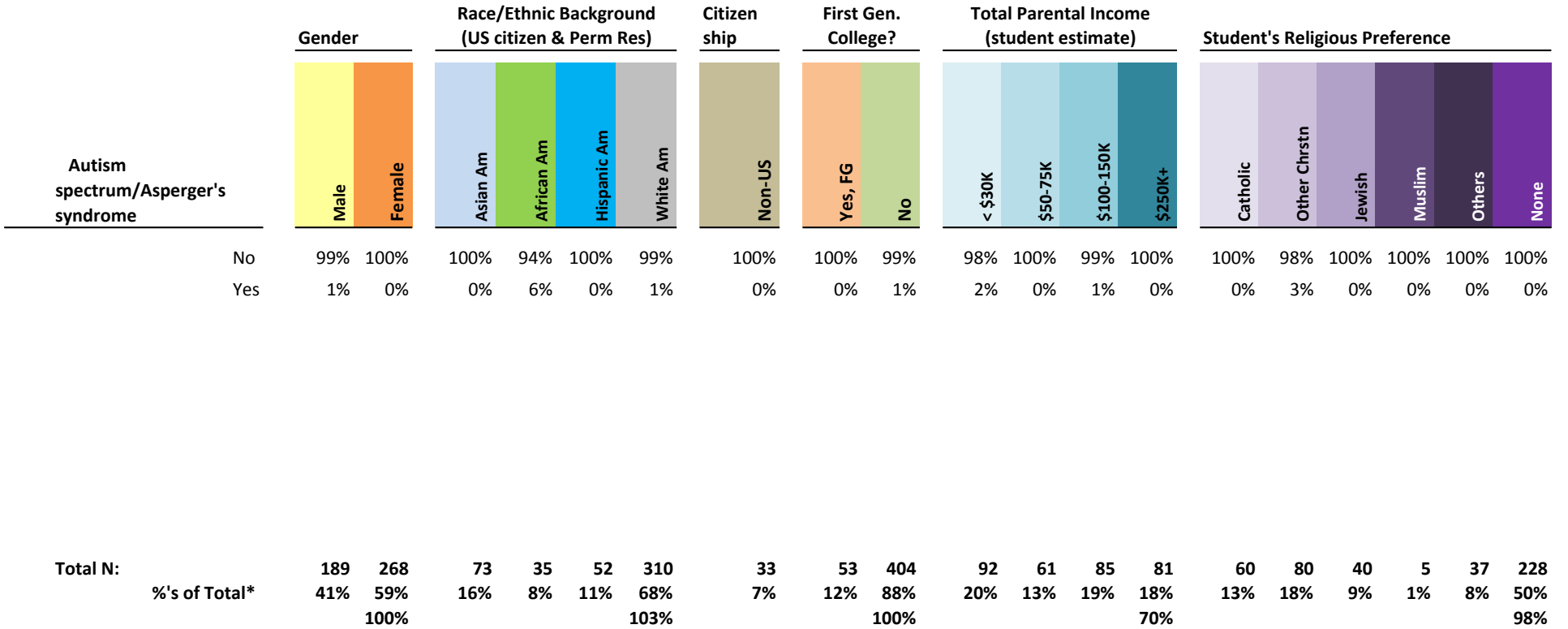

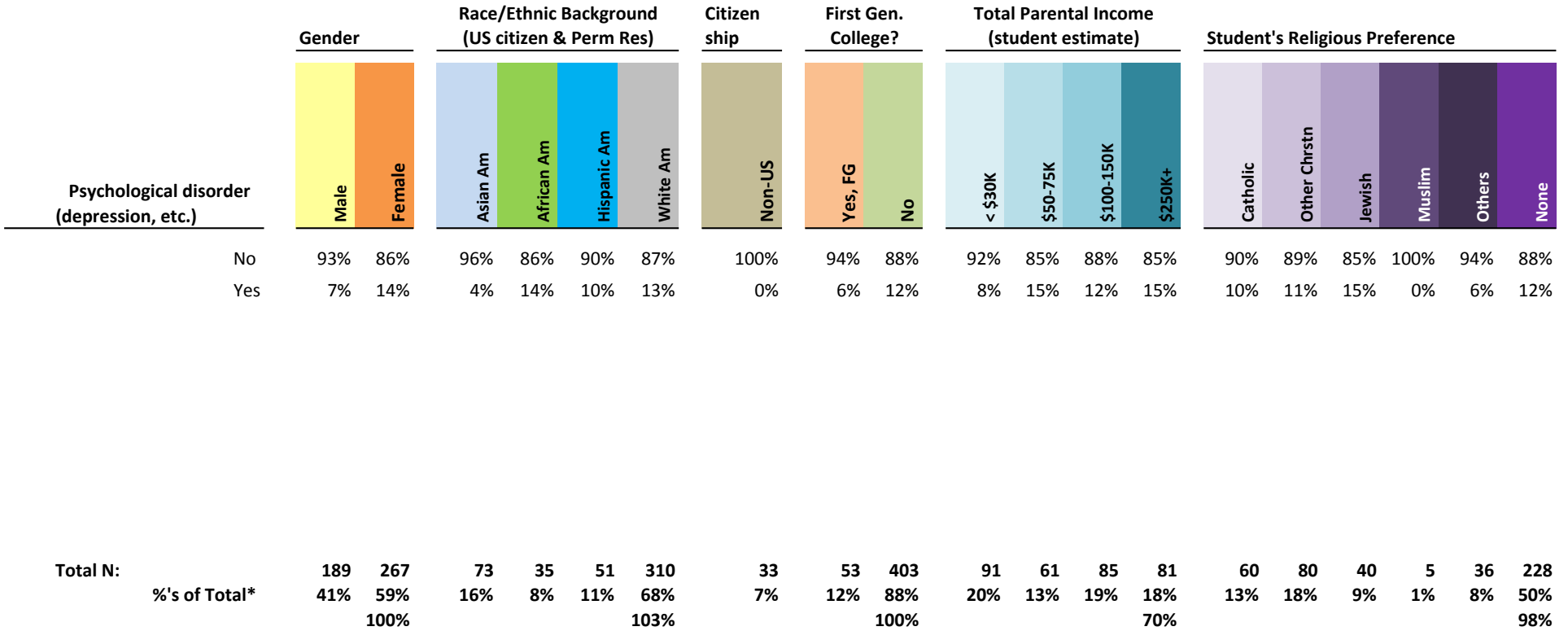

Psychological disorder (depression, etc.)



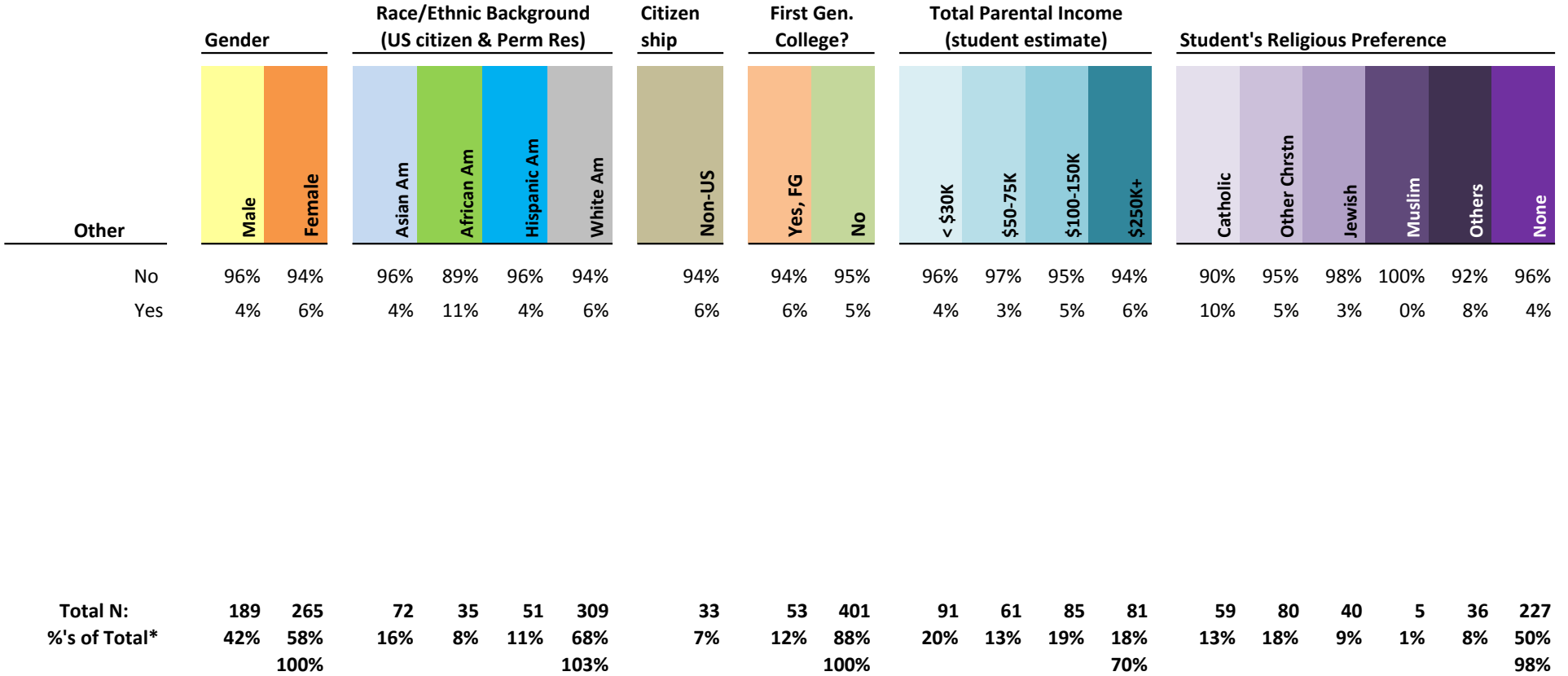
