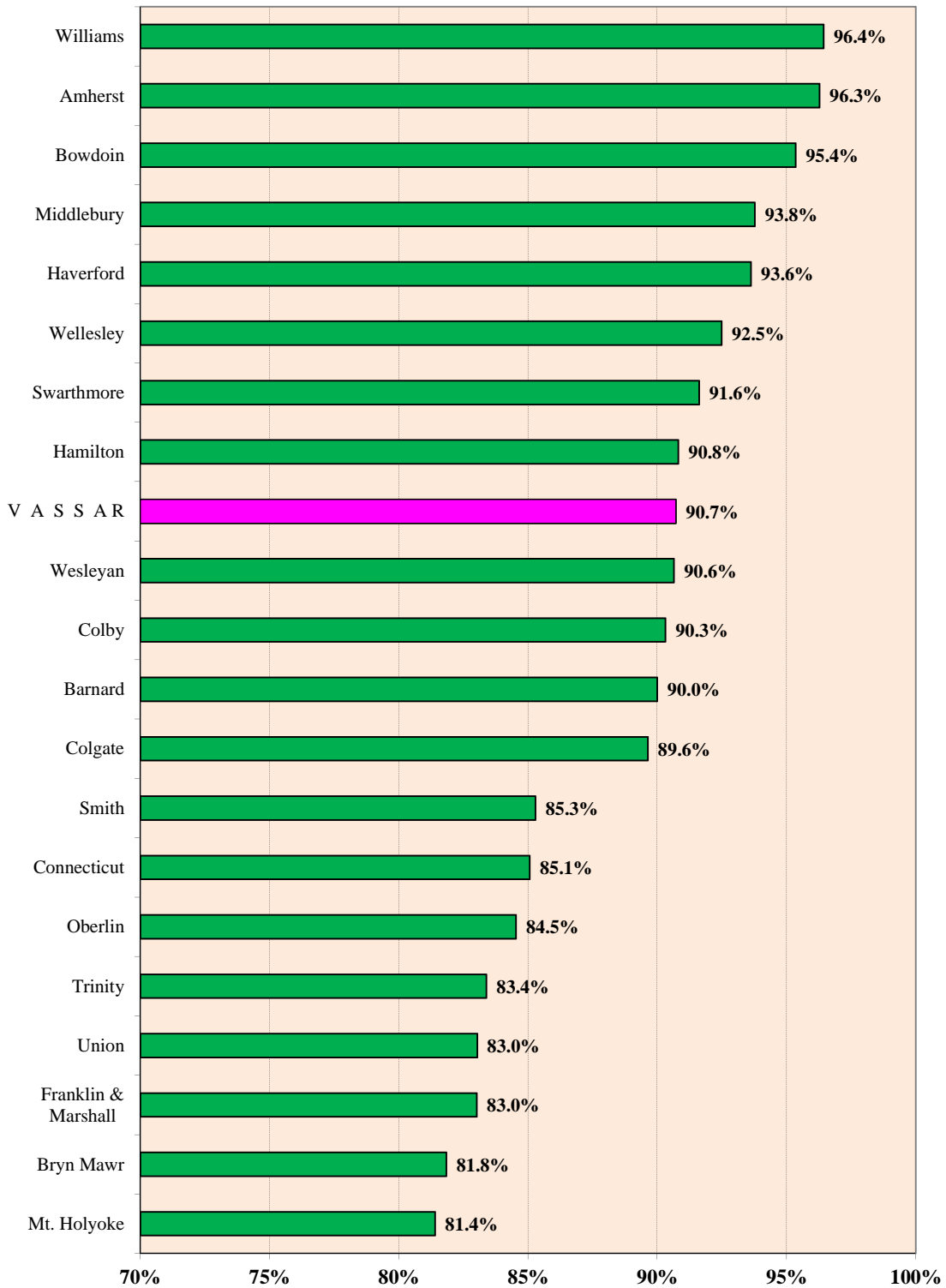

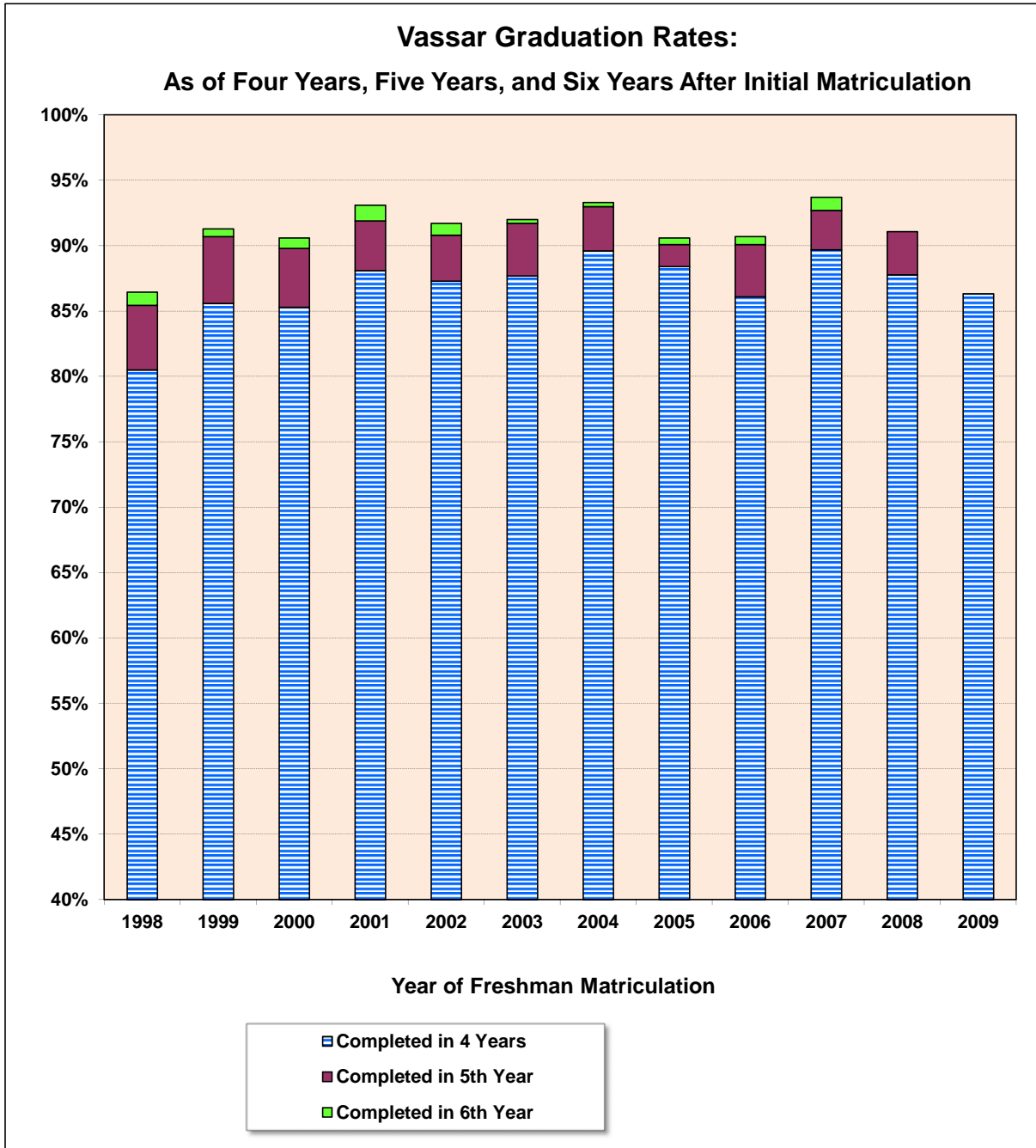


**Six-Year Graduation Rate - Class of 2010:

 For Vassar and its 21 Primary Reference Colleges**



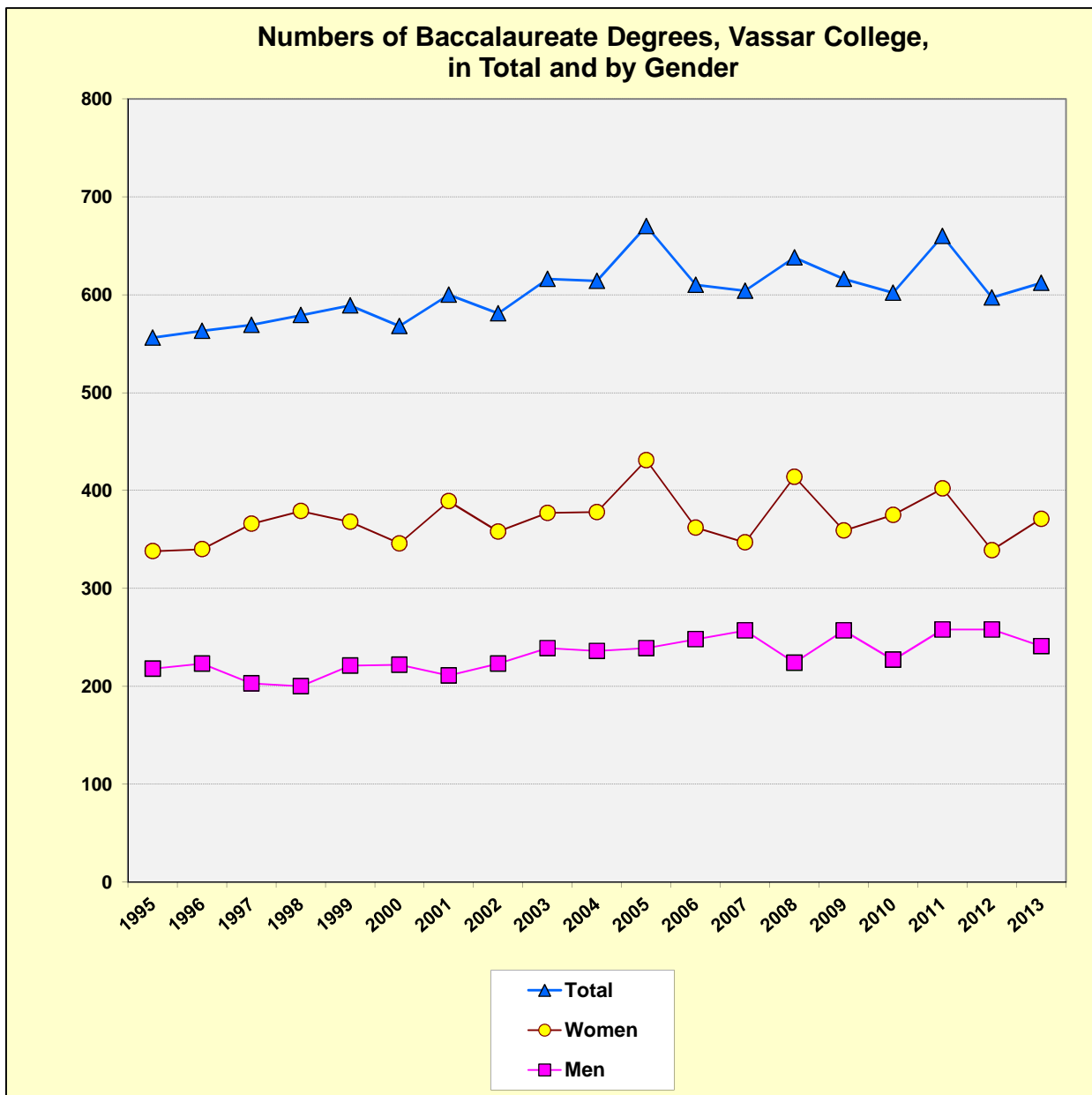

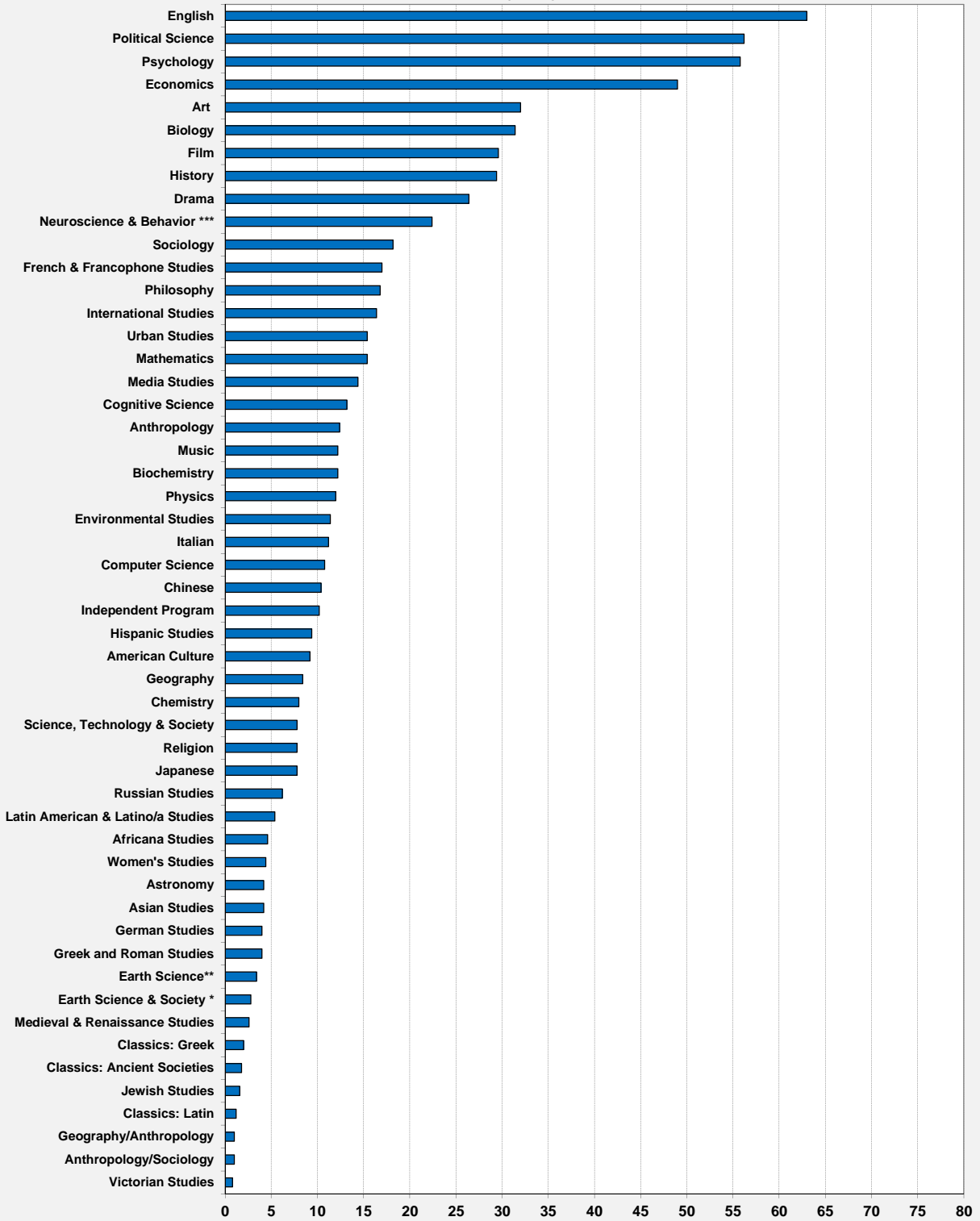

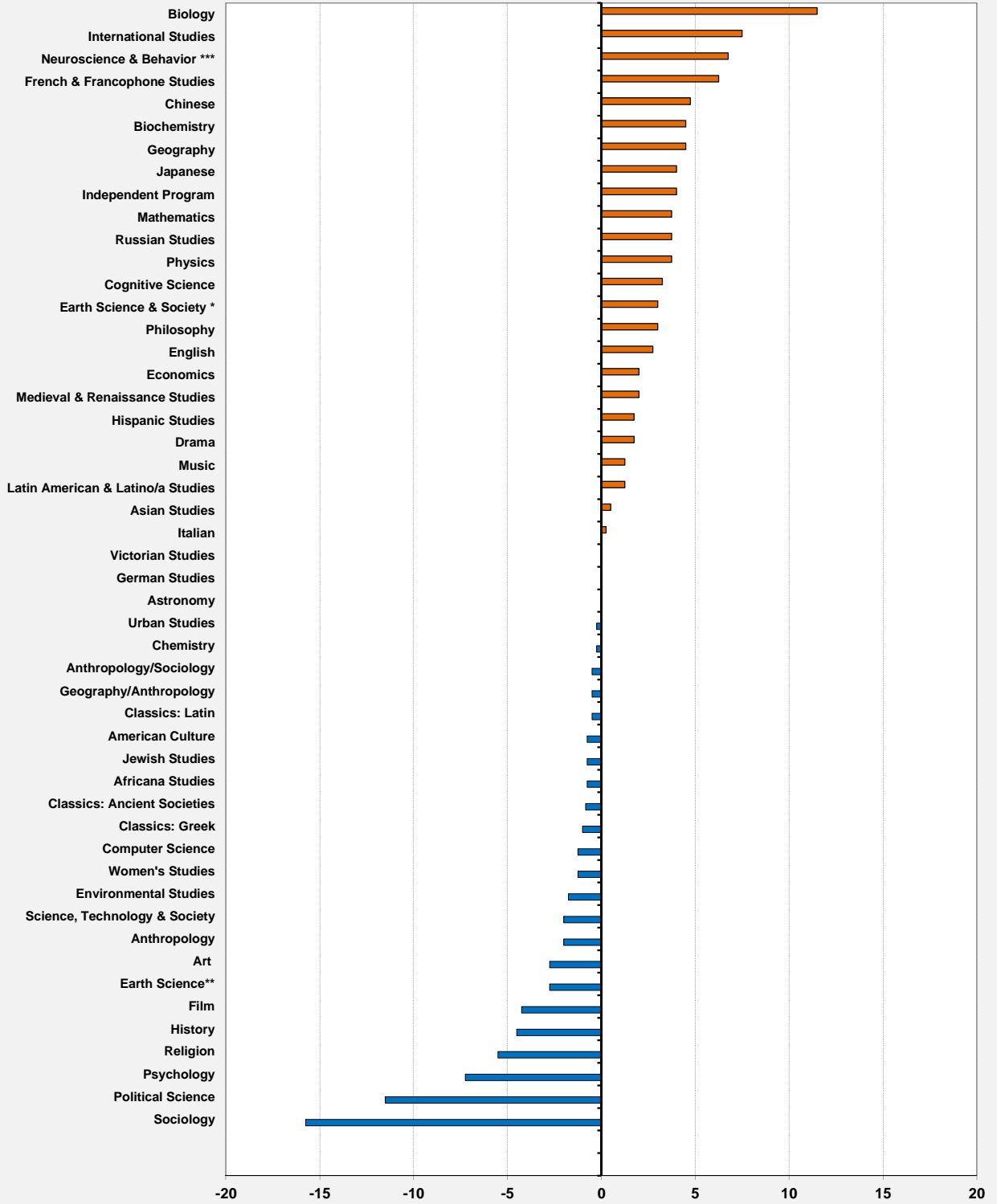

( 2010 through 2013 ) minus ( 2002 through 2005 )**

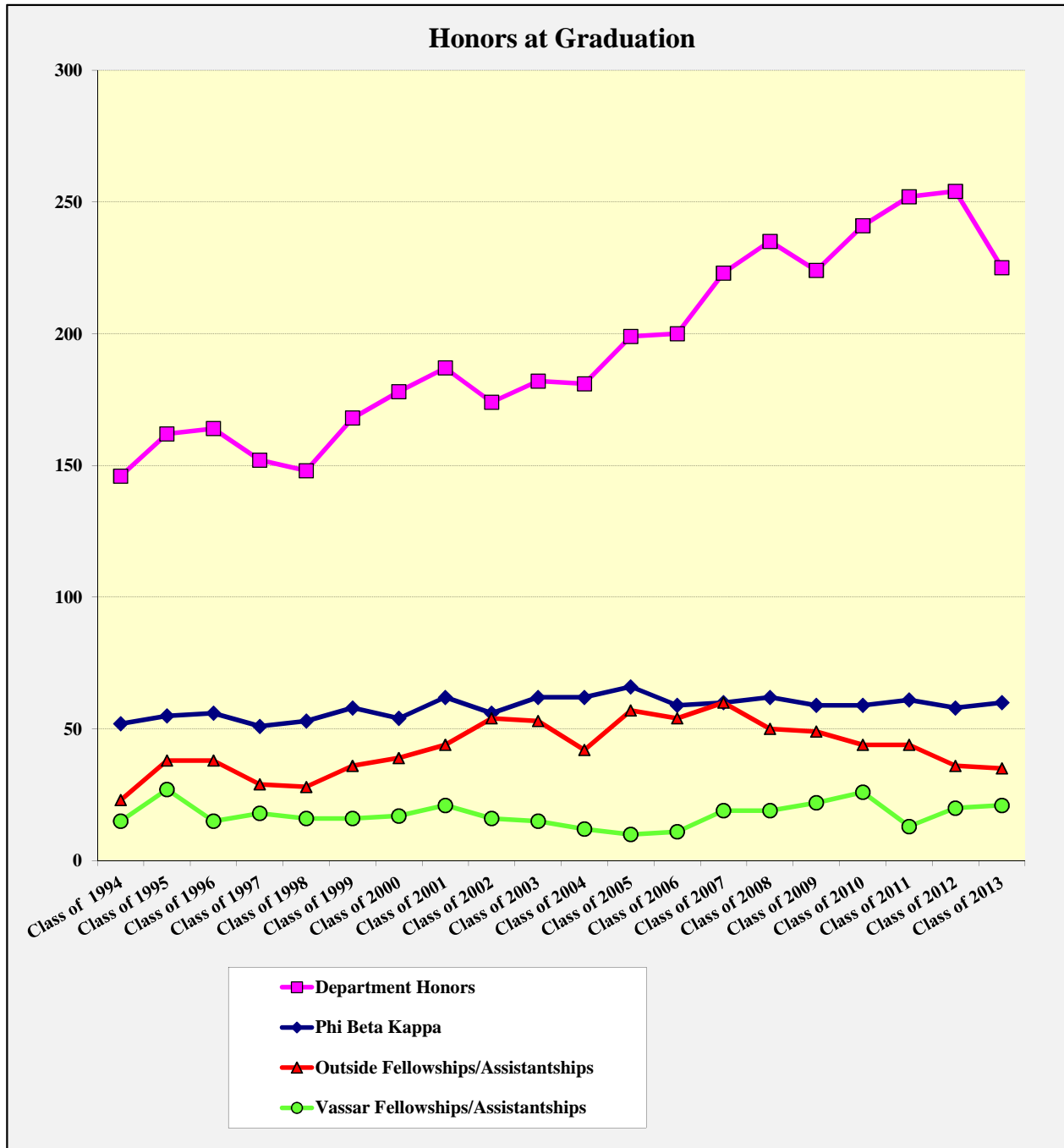
